



MWFPA SCHOLARSHIP

The MWFPA scholarship offers \$1,500 (minimum) awards to deserving children of parents or guardians who are employees of member companies and are a high school senior or post-secondary student accepted into, or attending any post-secondary school, in the United States.

ELIGIBILITY:

The MWFPA scholarships are awarded without regard to the student's major, field of study, or the educational institution they are attending. This scholarship is open to children whose parents work for a company that is a member in good standing of MWFPA, who are graduating seniors and accepted into any post-secondary school in the United States. This includes vocational and technical colleges, private trade schools and two and four-year colleges. Applicants must show a current grade point average of 3.0 (or higher).

CARLETON A. FRIDAY & KENNETH G. WECKEL SCHOLARSHIPS

Both the Friday and Weckel scholarships offer \$2,500 awards to deserving undergraduate students enrolled in the University's College of Agricultural and Life Sciences, UW–Platteville's School of Agriculture and UW–River Falls' College of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences. Students should express an interest in an internship or career in food processing.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students need only complete one application to apply for both the Carleton A. Friday scholarship and the Kenneth G. Weckel scholarship. Applicants must show a current grade point average of 3.0 (or higher).
