Description

The scholarship awards \$1,000 per scholarship to deserving children of parents or guardians who are employees of MWFPA member companies and are a high school senior or post-secondary student accepted into, or attending any post-secondary school, in the United States. A post-secondary school means an institution of education including a vocational and technical college, two-and four-year colleges and private trade schools. Winning applicants may attend these schools with any major of study.

Interested students must assemble and present all the following to be viewed by the MWFPA Human Resources Committee.

1. One completed application form available at www.mwfpa.org.
2. Grade point average of 2.50 or above on a 4.0 scale (transcript required)
3. Letter of reference from advisor or faculty member
4. Essay from the student focusing on their participation in school and community activities during their high school or post-secondary education and reason(s) for enrollment in a particular area of study (double-spaced and not to exceed 4 pages)
5. Address, email and phone number.

Incomplete applications and applications received/post marked after the deadline stated on the application will not be considered. Do not staple applications.
